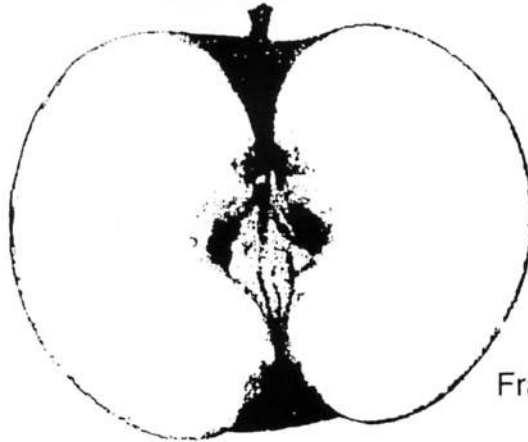
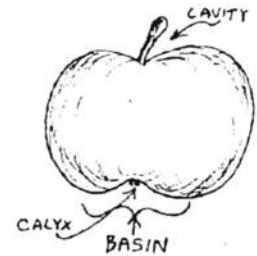

## FRANKLIN SWEET APPLE

LAST SEEN IN FRANKLIN COUNTY !

### **DESCRIPTION:**

Origin, Franklin county, Maine (?)

Tree vigorous, spreading productive.

Fruit large, roundish conical, regular, whitish yellow overlaid with crimson, with stripes and splashes of deeper crimson. Stem medium, 3/4", inserted in a medium, slightly russeted cavity; basin medium, regular; calyx closed. Flesh white, tender, sweet, rather dry; core small. Good. Season September.

A favorite with many for baking and dessert. Largely planted 50 years ago [1850], but seldom found at the present time. [1907]
