What is the MOFGA Ambassador Program?

The MOFGA Ambassador Program is a new opportunity for individuals to develop deeper community connections and gain leadership skills. The purpose of the program is to empower MOFGA volunteers around the state to effect positive change in the communities where they live and work.

MOFGA ambassadors will serve as part of a cohort, and ambassador terms will be one year in length. In this first year, MOFGA ambassadors will have the opportunity to co-create the program and design the work of the cohorts to come. They will be supported by MOFGA staff and offered leadership training to help them achieve personal and professional goals.

We are excited to invite the creativity and cooperation of our vast volunteer community. What can you contribute? How do you envision an ambassador serving in your community? What kind of support do you need to succeed? How will you lay the groundwork for those that follow you? Join us as a MOFGA Ambassador and make meaningful change!

Role and Responsibilities

Ambassadors will attend two in-person trainings on MOFGA's campus in Unity, the first in April 2025, to kick off the program; the second in March 2026, to celebrate the conclusion of the program. They will also meet via Zoom for 90 minutes each month. The amount of time dedicated to the program will vary depending upon interest. However, in our first program year in 2025, the focus for the Ambassador Program will be to design the program for the cohorts in future program years.

Ambassadors will uplift MOFGA's mission in a way that fits their cultural and community contexts and complements their interests. Our community contains a diversity of experience and expertise, and we are eager to see what we can create together!

Ambassadors will be announced on March 21, 2025, and the program will begin in April 2025. We encourage anyone who has the time and the passion to apply to the Ambassador Program. We are actively seeking applicants who represent a diversity of identities, experiences, and skills, but we ask that applicants be at least 16 years old.
